

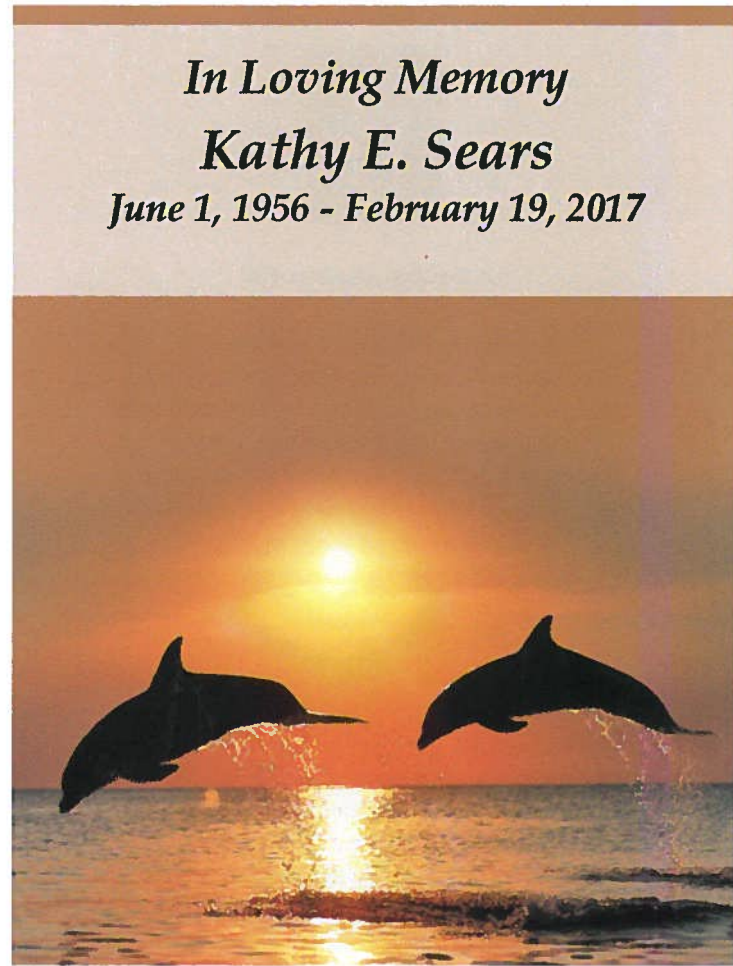
*Lord, make me an instrument of Thy peace;
