

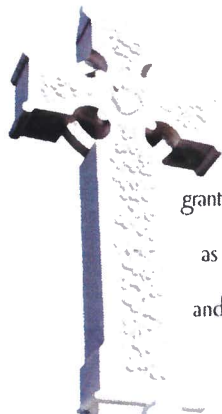
APPRECIATION
