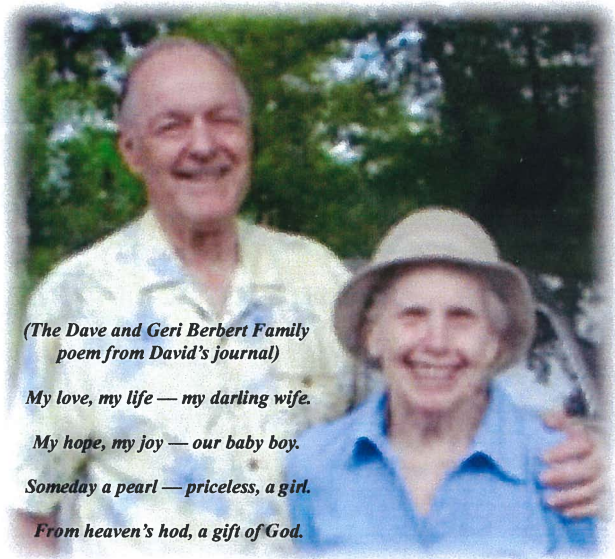


APPRECIATION
