and it is in pardoning, that we are pardoned

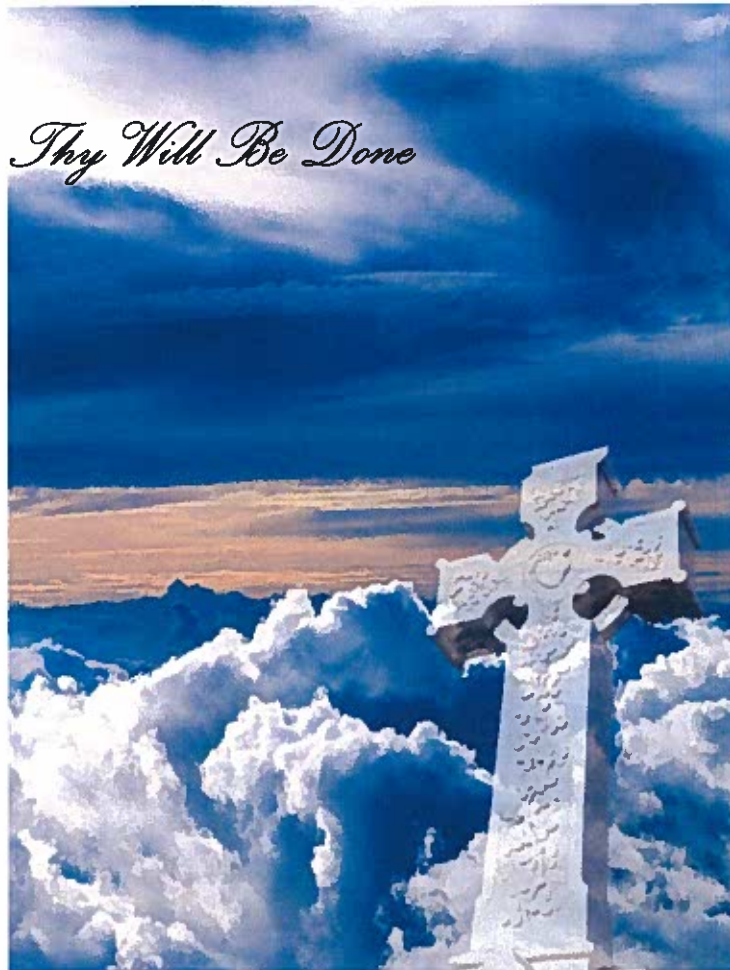
